ASSISTANT COACH

The Assistant Coach must:

- Be fully certified NCCP Level 3 (or equivalent in the new NCCP system) or higher as per the Canada Games Technical Package (Ed. 2), which states that "These coaches must be so certified not later than 90 days before the opening of the Games (ie by November 13, 2010)."
- Have a current Police Record Check and other signed documents as per Synchro Ontario Policies
- Be member in good standing with the Association
- Be a mature, knowledgeable, and experienced Coach
- Be a suitable ambassador of our province at both training events and at the Games
- Other credentials as per the Job Description

- 4-day Fall (Thanksgiving Weekend) training camp
- December Training Camp
- February Camp before the Games
- Traditional training practices throughout preparation period (Sept 2010-Feb 2011)
- Other training camps/practices as needed

- Attendance at/participation in Grant programs as available
